Suffolk Freemasons and CHAPS have teamed up to provide a programme for men aged 40 - 80 to have a Prostate Check. This is a simple blood test (PSA) that has achieved very good results in other programmes by highlighting the need for regular, risk based follow-up PSA Tests.

This is a Strictly Appointment only event, there is no walk-in facility

NB: Prostate tests are for men aged 40-80. Prostate Cancer Screening is strongly recommended for men of black African or Caribbean heritage and men with a family history of prostate cancer or breast and ovarian cancer who are thus at considerably higher risk from prostate cancer.

NHS Health Checks are for men aged 40-74 who are registered with a Suffolk GP and not already on treatment for a heart condition, blood pressure or high cholesterol, kidney disease or diabetes.
You are also not eligible if you already have had an NHS Health Check within the last 5 years.
